**Policy and Law References**

- University of California Implementing Guidelines for the California Gun-Free School Zone Act of 1995 and Amendments.
- UCLA Policy 131, Weapons On University Property

Excerpts:

“...no person shall bring to or possess on University Property or areas adjacent to University Property, a loaded or unloaded Firearm, Generally Prohibited Weapon, Lethal Weapon, Less Lethal Weapon, Stun Gun, Imitation Firearm, Fireworks or other Incendiary or Destructive Device.”

“UCLA students, faculty, and staff shall not bring to or possess a loaded or unloaded Firearm, Generally Prohibited Weapon, Lethal Weapon, Less Lethal Weapon, Stun Gun, Imitation Firearm, Fireworks or other Incendiary or Destructive Device to activities of or programs conducted by the University, whether on- or off-University Property.”

“Any person, who possesses a Firearm, Generally Prohibited Weapon, Lethal Weapon, Less Lethal Weapon, Stun Gun, Imitation Firearm, Fireworks, or Incendiary or Destructive Device on University Property or at off-campus University activities or programs, may be subject to criminal penalties and/or disciplinary action under University policies, except where one of the exceptions below applies.”

- California Penal Code § 626.9, § 626.10, and § 16590

Excerpts:

“...any person who brings or possesses a firearm upon the grounds of a campus of, or buildings owned or operated for student housing, teaching, research, or administration by, a public or private university or college, that are contiguous or are clearly marked university property, unless it is with the written permission of the university or college president, his or her designee...shall be punishable by imprisonment.” [CA Penal Code § 626.9(h)/(i) – California Gun-Free School Zone Act of 1995]

“Any person, except a duly appointed peace officer...who brings or possesses any dirk, dagger, ice pick, or knife having a fixed blade longer than 2 ½ inches upon the grounds of, or within...the University of California...is guilty of a public offense, punishable by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding one year, or by imprisonment” [CA Penal Code § 626.10(b)]

“... ‘generally prohibited weapon’ means any of the following: <see Penal Code>”. [CA Penal Code § 16590]

- California Health and Safety Code

Excerpts:

“It is unlawful for any person to possess dangerous fireworks without holding a valid permit.” [CA Health and Safety Code § 12677]

- Los Angeles Municipal Code

Excerpts:

“It shall be unlawful for any person to use, give, possess, sell, or discharge any fireworks in the City of Los Angeles.” [Los Angeles Municipal Code § 57.5608.1.2]

- Santa Monica Municipal Code

Excerpts:

“All fireworks shall be illegal in the City of Santa Monica including California State Fire Marshal Safe and Sane.” [Santa Monica Municipal Code § 8.40.020(f)].
